Direct School Admission

Scenario	Must you participate in S1 posting process? Why?
Your child applied to a school through the DSA -Sec process, & was rejected .	Your child must participate in the S1 posting process. MOE will respond to all appeals by early January .
Your child applied to a school through the DSA -Sec process, & was accepted .	Your child does not need to participate in the S1 posting process. However, you may participate if your child is: • eligible for more than one course. • eligible for and wishes to attend a third language programme.
Your child has accepted an offer from Singapore Sports School (SSP).	Your child must participate in the S1 posting process. You may then transfer your child to SSP after the S1 posting results are released. This is to ensure your child can return to their posted school if they subsequently need to leave SSP.
Your child is applying directly to a specialised school for Normal (Technical) students (SSNT), i.e. Spectra Secondary School and Crest Secondary School.	Your child must participate in the S1 posting process. This is to ensure they are posted to a secondary school in case their SSNT application is not successful. You will receive a letter and SMS if your SSNT application is successful.

- The <u>courses</u> and <u>schools</u> offered depends on their PSLE results.

Eligibility Letter

- 1. 2-course options
 - Express & Normal (Academic)
 - Normal (Academic) or Normal (Technical)
 - Your child should select the course first before applying to the school that offers the selected course.
- 2. Language programmes such as <u>Higher Mother Tongue Language</u> or a third language
- 3. Bonus points for admission to <u>Special Assistance Plan schools</u>, if your child performed well on the PSLE and in Higher Chinese
- 4. Edusave scholarships for independent schools, if your child is eligible

- Apply to School Directly from Nov 22 at 11 a.m. to Nov 26 at noon.
 Need to apply under S1 Posting Exercise as well
- Successful applicants will receive results via SMS and letter by
 Dec 13 & will not be posted to another school under S1 option.

How your child is posted

The posting process is based on **PSLE score**, **school preferences** and **vacancies** at the selected schools.

- Students with higher PSLE scores will be considered first for vacancies in their chosen schools.
- List your child's 6 secondary school options in order of **preference**. Use the cut-off points for each secondary school as a guide.
- Students who cannot be placed in any of their chosen schools will be posted to the nearest available school. For this reason, we advise parents to keep their home address updated with their child's primary school. Out of the 6 options, include one with a higher chance of having vacancy.
- Singapore citizens have priority in the case of a tied score.
 Between two students with the same citizenship, a tie is resolved by a computerised ballot with an equal chance for each student.

Appeals for Posting

- Your child must report to the posted secondary school on Dec 20 at 8.30 a.m. even if you intend to appeal for transfer.
- Apply for school transfer by collecting & submitting an application form to the posted secondary school by **noon** on that day.
- Appeals will only be considered for students with:
 - Serious medical conditions, such as chronic heart conditions or kidney problems
 - Dyslexia or Autism Spectrum Disorder
 - Physical disabilities, such as those requiring the use of a wheelchair or crutches
- Must bring the relevant supporting documents (e.g. medical reports, letters from doctors)

Appeals for Posting

- The staff at your child's posted secondary school will help file your appeal.
- MOE will respond to all appeals by early January.
- Students seeking transfer should continue to attend lessons in their posted secondary school until their transfer is approved.
- Transfers are subject to vacancies at the requested transfer school.

Matters on PSLE Certificates

- There is no replacement for lost or damaged certificates. However, pupil may purchase a Statement of Results from MOE Customer Service Centre. More information can be obtained from SEAB website at: https://www.seab.gov.sg/pages/purchase_of_SOR.asp
- 2. Amendment of Personal Particulars on the Certificate
 - a) All certificate amendments must be endorsed by the Principal or Vice-Principal of the school, using **Annex B - Amendment to Certificate Request Form**. Please obtain a copy from the General Office if necessary.
 - b) There is an administrative fee of S\$50 (inclusive of GST) for the amendment of each PSLE certificate.
 - c) The following documents must be submitted to the school by **28 December 2018**. Only completed application, with the following documents will be processed.
 - Completed Annex B Amendment to Certificate Request Form
 - Original PSLE Certificate
 - Photocopy of Deed Poll / Birth Cert
- d) The amended PSLE certificate will be issued to the school by 11 January 2019.
