School Attire and Personal Appearance

- Students are to wear the prescribed school uniform and modification to the uniform is • not allowed.
- Students are expected to observe closely the guidelines on school attire and personal appearance.

Hairstyle & Personal Appearance



For Boys:

- Hair is combed neatly. Forehead is not covered by long fringe. Hair is sloped and does not touch the collar at the back.
- Hair must not cover ears at the side.
- No fanciful hairstyles*.
- Male students must be clean-shaven and neat in appearance.

*Fanciful hairstyles include dyed/ coloured/ highlighted hair, or the undercut, in which the hair near the top of the head is longer while the back and/or sides are buzzed very short and spiky.

For Girls:

- Hair is neat and tidy and kept away from the face either by keeping hair short or with the use of black or dark blue accessories.
- Hair does not reach the collar of the uniform. Hair which is shoulder-length or longer is tied-up. Long fringe is pinned or tied up.
- Hair is of natural colour. Dyed/ coloured/ highlighted hair is not allowed.

Only a pair of small black, dark blue, or silver ear studs are allowed for the girls. For all boys and girls, jewellery and ornaments are not allowed. Fingernails must be short and varnish on the nails is not allowed.
